Melinda Guthrie Retires

On August 31, 2009, Melinda Guthrie is retiring from Texas A&M University-Central Texas. After twenty-seven years of service to the four universities that have been located in Killeen, she is ready to pass the baton to a new Director of Library Services. Ms Guthrie received a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Texas in Austin, a Master of Library Science from Texas Woman's University and a Master of Science in Human Resource Management from the University of Central Texas.



She was a reference and circulation Librarian at Southwestern University during the years of 1968-1969. She worked as a branch head Librarian for Houston Public Library from 1969-1974.

In 1982, she was hired as the University Librarian of American Technological University. From 1989-1999, she was the University Librarian for the University of Central Texas. From 1999-2009, Ms Guthrie has been the Killeen Division Head for the Tarleton State University Libraries.

Ms Guthrie's retirement party will be celebrated on August 12 at the TAMU-CT Southwest building, Room 111 from 2-4.
